



Intermediate Class Descriptions

I1 – Moving past Novice (3 1-hour sessions)

This class is for students who have completed the Novice classes and/or who have the equivalent Rally Novice skill from elsewhere. The class introduces CARO Intermediate/Advanced signs particularly those where dog and handler move in different directions. Leash handling is a key component for successful management of these signs. This class is also suitable for those who are moving directly from Novice to Advanced as the signs covered are those used off-leash at the Advance level.

This is an on-leash class with dogs & handlers active in the training area for the full time.

I2 – Solidly Intermediate (3 1-hour sessions)

This class adds the remainder of the Intermediate signs to the repertoire and includes sequences that allow the student to refine all the signs that could be included in an Intermediate Level trial. This is also suitable for those moving directly to the Advanced level.

This is an on-leash class with dogs & handlers active in the training area for the full time.

I3 –Crisp & Confident (4 1-hour sessions)

This class puts it all together with students sharpening their skills and learning to manage an Intermediate rally course. Emphasis will be placed on smooth execution of station signs. Sessions will include navigating regular and team courses.

This is an on-leash class with dogs & handlers active in the training area for the much time.

I4 – Intermediate Refresher (2 1-hour sessions)

This class is designed for those who have been away from Rally and want to refresh their skills in preparation for a trial or before progressing to other levels. This is not suitable for those who are just moving up to the Intermediate level as it assumes that students have been learning or working at this level but have questions about how signs are to be performed and/or want guided practice.

This is an on-leash class with dogs & handlers active in the training area for the full time.
